Set out garbage cans or bags **every second week**, according to the schedule for your Zone(see cover).

Every second week

Place garbage cart at the **curb** by 7:30 a.m. on your collection day. (Check garbage collection week for your zone on calendar).

Weekly

Place organics cart at the **curb** by 7:30 a.m. on your collection day; not before 8:00 p.m. the night before.

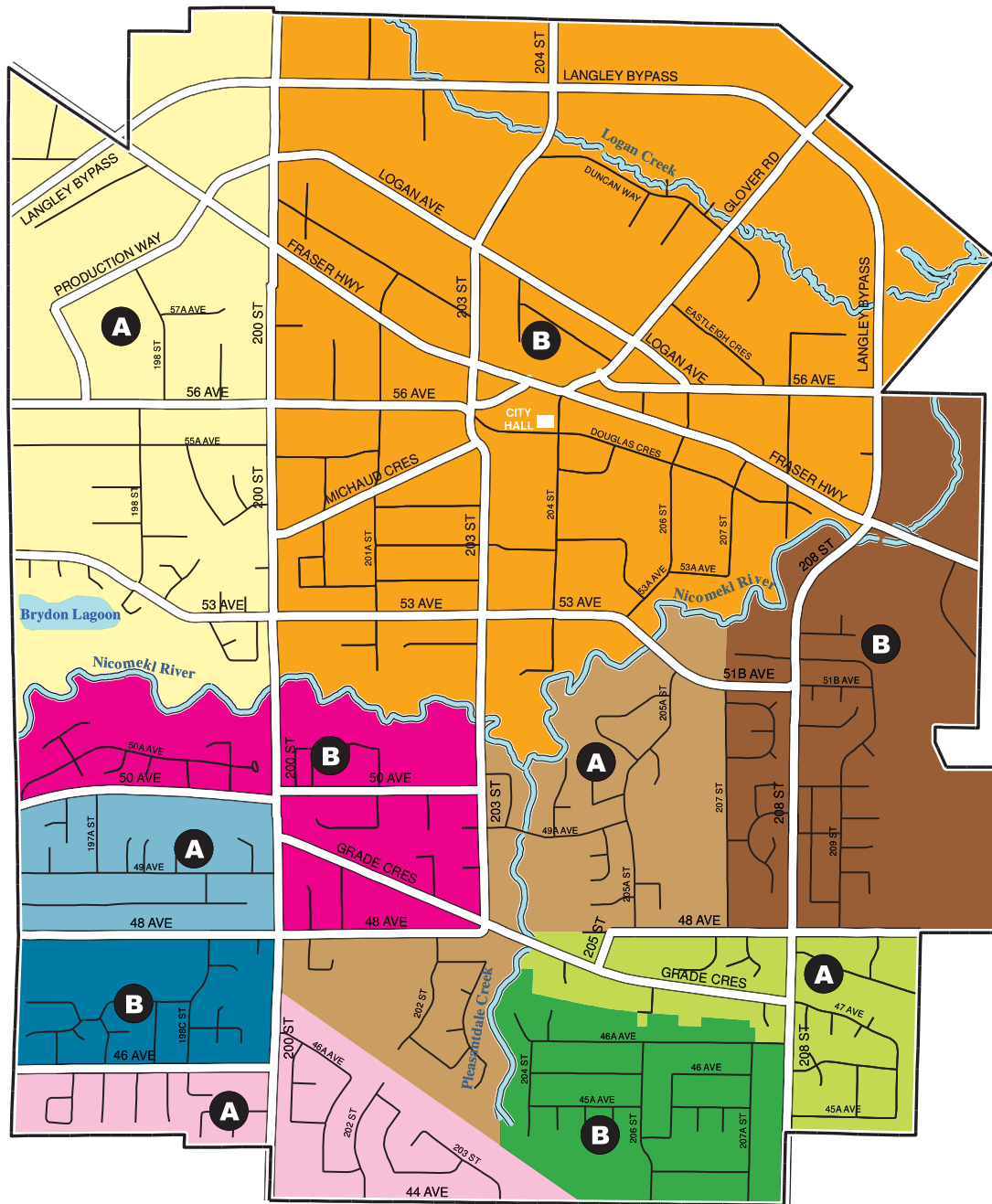

FOOD SCRAPS

- Fruits
- Vegetables
- Bones
- Meat, Poultry or Fish
- Cheese
- Eggs & Shells
- Bread & Grains



KITCHEN WASTE

- Shredded Paper
- Cardboard Egg Cartons
- Paper Towels
- Napkins
- Coffee Filters
- Tea Bags



YARD & PAPER WASTE

- Leaves
- Grass
- Clippings
- Small Branches
- Twigs & Prunings
- Wood Chips
- Plants & Flowers
- Straw
- Pumpkin
- Brown Paper Bags
- Newspaper

GREEN WASTE/YARD TRIMMING PROGRAM

The City provides weekly collection of green yard waste year round.

Acceptable green waste materials:

- leaves
- grass
- clippings
- branches
- kitchen food scraps
- newspaper and/or brown paper bags to hold green waste

Banned Materials From Garbage:

For a full list of banned materials visit metrovanvancouver.ca

- Beverage containers (except paper milk cartons)
- Recyclables accepted in the Recycle BC program (visit recyclebc.ca)
- Paints, solvents, flammable liquids, gasoline, pesticides
- Electronics: personal computers, TVs, printers, small appliances
- Corrugated cardboard
- Construction/renovation waste, Gypsum drywall
- Yard, garden and food waste
- Lead-acid car batteries, tires
- Medications/pharmaceuticals
- Newsprint, office paper
- Oil, oil filters and empty containers
- Dead animals

Large Items

Single Family residents receiving municipal curbside garbage collection may have four (4) large items such as furniture and appliances picked up by appointment at any time throughout the year.

TIPS FOR CART CARE

- Collect food scraps and other acceptable organic materials in a kitchen catcher.
- Line the catcher and green cart with newspaper or shredded paper.
- Layer kitchen waste with yard/garden waste to keep materials in the cart from sticking to the bottom.



Keep wildlife away by setting carts out just before **7 a.m. on collection day** and ensure lid is properly closed.



Place carts in a safe spot for collection, away from overhead obstacles, fences, and parked vehicles.



Carts should be kept clean to mitigate odours.
