

EMPLOYEE WELLNESS PROGRAM

The Employee Wellness Program* promotes healthy, active lifestyles among employees and their families by making recreation opportunities affordable and accessible. The City recognizes that healthier, active employees and their family members are more engaged; have increased motivation; improved mental health; fewer work related injuries and fewer sick days.

The Employee Wellness Program applies to Regular Full-Time, Regular Part-Time, Temporary Full-Time, Casual Employees and Paid-on-call Firefighters of the City of Langley. Please read the policy carefully as there are a few changes:

Regular Full-Time, Regular Part-Time and Temporary Full-Time Employees:

- a) \$10 per year fee to participate
- b) The annual fee includes drop-ins
- c) Family*** members receive 50% discount on admission packages (does not include single admission drop-ins)
- d) Employees and family members receive 20% discount on registered programs**

Casual Employees and Paid-on-call Firefighters:

- a) \$10 per year to participate
- b) Employees have to be actively working to receive pass
- c) Casual Employees can renew with a current pay stub
- d) The annual fee includes drop-ins

**Employee means a member of Langley City Council, an exempt staff person with the City of Langley, a member of CUPE Local 2058 or a member of Langley City's Firefighters' Union Local 3253.*

When an employee retires, leaves the City or is no longer working with the City of Langley, the wellness pass is no longer valid.

*** Excludes contract and advanced aquatics programs*

****Family is immediate family members (children and partner) living in the same home; limit 2 adults per family and children 24 years and under, if they are a student and living at home.*
