

PUBLIC NOTICE IS GIVEN that advance voting opportunities will be offered for eligible electors of the City of Langley.

ADVANCE VOTING DATES AND LOCATIONS

Advance Voting Opportunities will be held at Timms Community Centre, 20399 Douglas Crescent, Langley as indicated below:

Tuesday, **October 6**, 2026 from 1:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Wednesday, **October 7**, 2026 from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Thursday, **October 8**, 2026 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Wednesday, **October 14**, 2026 from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Curbside Voting will be available for anyone who cannot enter a voting location due to mobility challenges. Information on how to request curbside voting will be posted on the City's website and posted outside of the voting location on voting day.

ELECTOR REGISTRATION

The City of Langley uses the provincial voters list as its list of electors and maintains its own list of registered non-resident property electors. Together these form the City's official list of electors. If you voted in a past city, provincial, or federal election, it is likely you are on the list of electors. To find out if you are on the list of electors, you can contact the election staff below. If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the application form available at the voting location and making a declaration that you meet the requirements to be registered as set out below.

To register you must meet ALL of the following requirements at the time of voting:

- Age 18 years or older on general voting day October 17, 2026;
- Canadian citizen;
- resident of B.C. for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration;
- resident of the City of Langley on the day of registration; OR
- registered owner of real property in the City of Langley for at least 30 days immediately preceding the day of registration; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or assent voting and not otherwise disqualified by law.

To register as a resident elector, produce **two pieces of identification** to prove identity and residency, at least one with a signature OR produce two pieces of identification to provide evidence of identity, at least one with a signature, and make a solemn declaration as to residency. Picture identification is not required.

To register as a non-resident property elector, produce **two pieces of identification** to prove identity, at least one with a signature; **proof** of entitlement to register in relation to the property; and, if more than one property owner is named on title, **written consent** from a majority of the other property owners.

If you apply to vote by mail and are not on the list of electors, the required elector registration form(s) will be included in your mail ballot package to be completed and returned with your mail ballot.

ACCEPTABLE IDENTIFICATION

The following documents will be accepted as combined evidence of identity and residency:

- BC Driver's Licence
(combined Driver's Licence and Services Card is one piece of ID)
- BC Services Card (photo or non-photo)
- BC CareCard
- Owner's Certificate of Insurance & Vehicle Licence (ICBC)
- Social Insurance Number card
- Canadian Citizenship Card
- Property tax notice issued by City of Langley
- Credit card or Debit card
- Utility Bill for electricity, natural gas, water, telephone, or cable services
- Document that certifies registration as an Indian under the Indian Act (issued by Canadian government)
- Citizenship or membership card issued by a first nation
- Citizenship card issued by Métis Nation British Columbia

An election official may also accept other forms of documents that provide evidence satisfactory to the election official (for example, a valid, current passport).
