- Check the interior of your vehicle, before leaving your vehicle.
- Remove your garage door opener from your vehicle, whether you are parking outside or in underground parking.
- Lock the entrance leading into your house from the garage.
- If you live in a multi-family residence with underground parking wait for the gate to close; don't give anyone the chance to follow you in.
- Remove anything and everything from your vehicle; the change from the console, the mail you picked up at your postal box...thieves will steal anything and everything.
- Always lock your vehicle doors and make sure all your windows are up.
- If you are thinking about placing items in your trunk; do so before reaching your destination.
- Don't leave your vehicle running and unlocked even for a "moment".
- When possible park in well-lit areas.
- If your vehicle does not have an immobilizer consider having one installed; you can receive a discount on your insurance. Another option is to use a steering wheel lock; these are a great deterrent if used and not left on the floor.
