The most effective and efficient way to report a suspicious person/activity or a crime that has already occurred is to call the non-emergency number as soon possible after the occurrence. If reporting a suspicious person: what are they doing that makes their activity suspicious? For example: checking doors of vehicles, knocking on your neighbour's front door and then going to the back gate.

Call this number if you are witnessing a crime/incident in progress; know your location. This could be where a moving van is in your neighbour's driveway and you know they are on vacation, not moving. You could be at the scene of a serious vehicle crash or a fight. You may be asked to remain at the scene to provide an eye witness account until the police arrive.

- The incident has occurred in either the City or Township of Langley (Walnut Grove, Aldergrove, Willoughby, Brookwood, Fort Langley)

You can use Online Crime reporting if:

You have lost something that costs less than \$5000
Someone has stolen something from you that costs less than \$5000
Someone has vandalized your property or vehicle and it will cost less than \$5000 to repair it
The crime happened within the jurisdiction of the Langley RCMP
You want to report a Driving Complaint that is not in progress

You **cannot use** Online Crime reporting if:

- There is a witness or suspect (this restriction does not apply to Driving Complaints)
- There are lost or stolen items involving personal identity, firearms, license plates or decals

What happens to the Information?

Langley RCMP has a Crime Analyst team reviewing the type of report/occurrences you are calling in to determine if there is an increase in any type of criminal behaviour. The information you have provided assists to effectively deploy our officers, specialized units and volunteers.
